6. "A mechanic can only correct a mechanical flaw. She has no way of seeing a demon, let alone fixing or getting rid of one. To the owner, the demon may be causing the intake flow problem, but that is of no concern to the mechanic. She does not know if demons exist because they are not measurable. She can only deal with material, measurable things --- the engine. This is a natural cause which explains the naturally occurring event."

7. "Science has limits, it can only deal with that which is natural... that is, can be either directly or indirectly (using instruments) perceived through the senses. Items which cannot be currently perceived by the senses cannot currently be dealt with by science. This does NOT exclude observations of EVIDENCE of unseen events. Much of science involves INFERENCES based on observed circumstantial evidence, especially if these come from multiple independent fields of study (such as the reconstruction of extinct ecosystems and creatures from fossils collected and the associated geology)."
